ED + SH picked-up what appears to be salt (road, salt, etc.) Crystallized, hardened and down ravine near pumphouse into San Pablo Creek. - Specialists cleaned area but left furniture, plastic etc solid waste for public works. Disposal arranged via "Parc Specialty Contractors."
