**REPORT:**

ON 2/13/2017 AT APPROXIMATELY 10:53 HRS- EAST BAY REGIONAL PARKS DEPARTMENT (EBRPD) CONTACTED CONTRA COSTA HEALTH SERVICES HAZARDOUS MATERIALS PROGRAMS (CCHS-HMP) REGARDING A LEAKING 5 GALLON CONTAINER OF PAINT THINNER ON THE BAY TRAIL. THE ABANDONED MATERIAL SPILLED IN THE INTERTIDAL ZONE OF SF BAY.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1120 HRS - CCHS-HMP HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SPECIALISTS (HMS) CHRIS TOUGERON, XAVIER BRYANT, AND SARA DWIGHT RESPONDED TO THE SCENE IN HM3.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1145 HRS - HM3 ARRIVED AT THE END OF RYDIN ROAD, RICHMOND AND MET WITH EBRPD PARK RANGER KEITH CASILLAS. RANGER CASILLAS STATED THAT AT 9:45 AM RICHMOND FIRE NOTIFIED EBRPD ABOUT A 5 GALLON CONTAINER ABANDONED NEAR THE WATER ON THE BAY TRAIL. RANGER CASILLAS MOVED THE LEAKING CONTAINER FROM THE INTERTIDAL ZONE, PLACED THE CONTAINER INTO A PLASTIC TRASH BAG, AND TRANSPORTED THE CONTAINER ON EBRPD PROPERTY TO A TRAIL ENTRANCE AT THE END OF RYDIN ROAD. MR. CASILLAS STATED THAT HE OBSERVED SOME OF THE MATERIAL ON THE GROUND IN THE INTERTIDAL ZONE OF SF BAY.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1205 HRS - HMS DWIGHT AND BRYANT IDENTIFIED THE MATERIAL IN THE 5 GALLON CONTAINER TO BE FLAMMABLE. THE CONTAINER WAS DETERMINED TO BE APPROXIMATELY 1/2 FULL (2.5 GALLONS).

AT APPROXIMATELY 1200 HRS - HMS TOUGERON AND RANGER CASILLAS OBSERVED THE SPILLED MATERIAL IN THE INTERTIDAL ZONE OF SF BAY. ACCORDING TO RANGER CASILLAS HE EXPECTED HIGH TIDE TO BE AROUND 1500 HRS.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1225 HRS - HMS TOUGERON, BRYANT, DWIGHT PACED THE LEAKING 5 GALLON CONTAINING A FLAMMABLE MATERIAL INTO 15 GALLON METAL DRUM WITH PROPER LABELING AND CREATED A BILL OF LADING.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1245 HRS - HM3 ARRIVED AT THE BAY TRAIL OFF CRYSTAL COVE TO ADDRESS SPILLED MATERIAL. HMS DWIGHT AND BRYANT REMOVED APPROXIMATELY 2 CUBIC FEET OF SOIL AND A SMALL AMOUNT OF AN OILY SHEEN FROM THE WATER. THE WASTE MATERIAL WASTE PLACED INTO A 15 GALLON METAL DRUM.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1325 HRS - HM3 CLEARED THE SCENE.
