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REPORT:

Police responded to an odor complaint regarding a deceased tenant in an apartment building. Tenant had a history of manufacturing explosives, so the Walnut Creek Bomb Squad was notified. Bomb Squad checked the apartment for any evidence of explosives or manufacturing, and removed several unknowns they weren't sure about and tested them for reactivity. Compounds were found to be non-explosive. At this point HazMat was notified and requested to further clear the scene, and identify unknowns and potentially dispose of them. Bomb Squad would be gone by the time HazMat arrived.
