REPORT:

Notified from Sheriff Dispatch that East CoCo County Fire requests response for a gasoline release of approximately 40 gallons to the ground, unknown if storm drains are impacted.

MD spoke to Capt. Guerrero to get more information about the incident. Lots of odors, and without monitoring equipment, FD is unsure if the customer's car should be moved as it is in the middle of the release, with liquid gasoline underneath the car.

MD advises that we will respond to provide monitoring and consult if the car is able to be moved from the spill area.

XB, TH, MD, NU Respond to location.

Meet with Capt. Gil Guerrero at edge of canopy. Monitoring shows no readings, but odors are detectable.

Plan of action: monitor area where car is parked. Monitor storm drains, advise RP of clean up considerations.

Liquid product is no longer observable. Staining is present. Customer's car is clear to leave the area based on monitoring.

Monitoring the stained area readings of 7ppm. Monitoring of the Storm drain, 32ppm Note: even though readings are below levels of concern for health effects, odors are pretty strong at times during the incident.

Investigation of down stream drains/locations, no detectable/observable fuel in storm drains down stream.

Advise RP to consider pressure washing of stained area to prevent odors from impacting residential neighborhood directly across the street. Have clean up company clean/monitor the storm drain, and change filter. Advise to send clean up documents to CCHS - Attention, Maria Duazo
