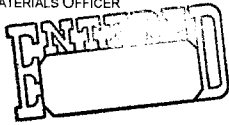

REPORT:

CCHSHMP assisted Richmond Fire Dept. Haz Mat and Con Fire Sta. 69/Battalion 7 in the mitigation and clean-up of a diesel spill from a tractor-trailer's saddle tank. Tractor-trailer had a DOT placard 1824 (for sodium hydroxide/caustic soda), but was carrying an empty trailer. The driver had collided with the center divide on I-80W at the San Pablo Dam Rd. exit, impacting the 50-gallon saddle tank, and spilling diesel fuel onto the freeway. He came to a stop at the right side of the freeway near the I-80W on-ramp from San Pablo Dam Rd. The diesel had entered a nearby storm drain. However, CCHSHMP had assessed though the fuel entered the storm drain, debris and trash in the drain had appeared to have absorbed the fuel, preventing the fuel from leaving the storm drain.

Due to slow traffic on I-80W from closure of the two right lanes because of this transportation accident, CCHSHMP (HM1/6824 - Asuncion and Ackerman) had arrived at the scene at 13:21. CHP was on scene to control traffic and secure the scene. Richmond Fire Dept. Haz Mat 64 and Con Fire Sta. 69 had placed absorbent onto the freeway to mitigate the spilled diesel. Richmond Fire had placed a pool underneath the tractor to capture the leaking fluid until the tow company had arrived. CCHSHMP provided Plug N' Dike material to Richmond Fire to plug the leaking saddle tank. CCHSHMP. HM3/6868 - Duazo and Dwight were requested to respond to the San Pablo Dam Rd. incident after the Hercules one in the event that crews needed more material to mitigate the leak or if pump-out of saddle tank is needed. HM3 arrived at 14:00. Pump-out of fuel from the tank was not needed.


Cal Trans had arrived to finish up clean-up of the diesel spill. They had come from an earlier transportation incident on I-80W and San Pablo Ave. in Hercules.

CCHSHMP HM1 and HM3 departed from the scene at 15:20.
