REPORT:

11/08/2016 - I, T. Asuncion, and Sara Dwight proceeded to the Concord DMV parking lot in Vehicle 6131/HM4. Lacey Friedman was in the area already and went directly to the purported Molotov cocktail. Friedman made contact with Con Fire Engine 9. Given the low-hazard of the situation, as the container was no longer burning, she recommended that Fire and Police be released, and I agreed. She waited until the arrival of HM4 to ensure that the container is secured and does not pose a public hazard.

On arrival, I screwed the lid and observed that its contents appeared to be waste oil. Dwight and I picked up the 5-gallon metal container and returned to the office. We used Chlor-D-Tect to make sure that the waste oil is below 1000 ppm (chlorinated components), which it was. We consolidated the waste oil in the yard's 55-gallon waste oil drum. Because the 5-gallon metal container had remaining oil sludge, we placed the container in a 55-gallon drum liner with other oily debris from this call-out. See attached Bill of Lading.
