**REPORT:**

HOMEOWNER HIRED TWO WORKERS TO PAINT HER HOUSE. WHILE WORKER WERE CLEARING ITEMS FROM SIDE OF HOUSE TO PREP FOR PAINTING THE WORKERS DISCOVERED AN AMMO BOX CONTAINING TWO CYLINDRICAL CONTAINERS WITH TREFOIL SYMBOL ON THEM. WORKERS REPORTED TO BECOME INSTANTLY DIZZY AND LEFT THE AREA.

AT 12:15 HOURS EAST CONTRA COSTA FIRE DISTRICT (ECCCFD) REQUESTED CCCHS HMP TO ASSIST WITH THE INCIDENT.

AT 12:34 HOURS HM3 (CONTAINING MPD, AS, & DL) AND HM1 (CONTAINING JP & MJD) DEPARTED THE OFFICE TO RESPOND. DV TO RESPOND IN SUV.

AT APPROXIMATELY 13:00 HOURS HM1 & HM3 ARRIVED ON SCENE. INITIAL RADIATION READING WERE TAKEN TO VERIFY THAT ALL PERSONNEL PRESENT WERE IN A SAFE LOCATION. CCCHS HMP CLEARED ALL THE UP TO THE DRIVEWAY, BACKGROUND RADIATION ONLY.

ECCCFD INFORMED CCCHS HMP THAT THE HOMEOWNER'S DECEASED HUSBAND SOLD MATERIALS TO HOSPITALS, PRIMARILY IN THE RADIOLOGICAL LABS AND THAT THE TWO WORKERS HAVE BEEN DECONNED AND APPEAR TO BE FINE.

AT APPROXIMATELY 13:40 HOURS MJD AND DV MADE ENTRY TO ASSESS THE SCENE FOR RADIATION AND UNKNOWN GASSES (BACKUP TEAM BEING DL AND AS). MJD AND DV DID A FULL 360 OF THE EXTERIOR OF THE PROPERTY BEFORE ASSESSING THE KNOWN LOCATION OF THE RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL. MJD AND DV DID NOT DETECT ANYTHING OTHER THAN STANDARD BACKGROUND RADIATION DURING 360 OF THE PROPERTY. MJD AND DV THEN PROCEEDED TO LOCATION OF THE RADIOLOGICAL SOURCE. MJD AND DV DID NOT DETECT ANYTHING OUTSIDE OF BACKGROUND RADIATION FROM THE EXTERIOR OF THE AMMO CAN. UPON OPENING THE AMMO CAN TWO PIGS WERE DISCOVERED INSIDE, ONE OF WHICH WAS OPEN. MJD AND DV VERIFIED THAT THE OPEN PIG HAD NO RADIOLOGICAL SOURCE INSIDE BEFORE PROCEEDING TO THE CLOSED PIG. MJD AND DV SLOWLY OPENED THE CLOSED PIG TO FIND IT ALSO DID NOT HOUSE A RADIOLOGICAL SOURCE. MJD AND DV PROCEED TO THE GARAGE, WHICH THEY DID NOT DETECT ANY RADIOLOGICAL SOURCES INSIDE.

AT APPROXIMATELY 13:55 HOURS CCCHS HMP INFORMED THE HOMEOWNER, WORKERS, AND ECCCFD THAT THE TWO CYLINDRICAL CONTAINERS FOUND WERE FUNCTIONAL PIGS USED TO TRANSPORT RADIOLOGICAL SOURCES SAFELY AND THAT BOTH PIGS WERE IN FACT EMPTY AND POSED NO RISK.

AT APPROXIMATELY 14:20 HOURS CCHS HMP DEPARTED SCENE.

NO FURTHER ACTION REQUIRED.
