VEHICLE ACCIDENT RESULTING IN 150 GALLON SADDLE TANK OF DIESEL FUEL RUPTURING RESULTING IN FUEL IN ROADWAY DOWN TO STORM DRAIN. TRUCK HAS A CAPACITY OF 150 GALLONS, UNKNOWN AMOUNT IN STORM DRAIN.

REPORT:

AT APPROXIMATELY 15:30 HOURS CHP REQUESTED CONTRA COSTA HEALTH SERVICES HAZARDOUS MATERIALS PROGRAMS (CCHSHMP) TO ASSIST WITH OFFLOADING A SADDLE TANK ON AN OVERTURNED SEMI-TRUCK.

AT APPROXIMATELY 15:45 HOURS HM3 (MJD AND JP) AND 3645 (MK) DEPARTED THE OFFICE.

AT APPROXIMATELY 16:00 HOURS HM3 AND 3645 ARRIVED ON SCENE. CHP/CALTRANS INFORMED CCCHS HMP

AT APPROXIMATELY 16:05 HOURS MK AND MJD ASSESSED THE SCENE DETERMINING THAT ONLY ONE SADDLE TANK REMAINED AND NEEDED TO BE OFFLOADED. MK AND MJD LOCATED THE IMPACTED STORM DRAINS ON THE OFFRAMP AND WHERE THEY DISCHARGED TO. MK AND MJD DETERMINED THAT THE DIESEL WAS NOT AN IMMEDIATE THREAT TO THE WATERWAY BECAUSE A CEMENT CURB STOPPED IT FROM ENTERING THE STORM DRAINS ON STREET LEVEL. MK AND MJD DETERMINED THAT FIRST ACTION SHOULD BE REMOVING THE DIESEL FROM THE REMAINING SADDLE TANK.

AT APPROXIMATELY 16:30 HOURS THE LOCATION AROUND THE REMAINING SADDLE TANK WAS DETERMINED TO BE SAFE VIA 4-GAS METER AND PID. GROUNDING AND BOUNDING WAS THEN DONE WITH A RESISTANCE OF 9.3 OHMS ACHIEVED.

AT APPROXIMATELY 17:00 HOURS DL AND XB WERE ENTRY TEAM WITH MK AND JP AS BACKUP. DL AND XB SUCCESSFULLY STUNG THE SADDLE TANK AND OFFLOADED APPROXIMATELY 40 GALLONS OF DIESEL FROM IT.

CALTRANS TO HIRE CONTRACTOR FOR CLEANUP OF OFFRAMP STORM DRAIN AND TO REMOVE CONTAMINATED SOIL AT OFFRAMP DRAIN OUTLET.

CCHSHMP DETERMINED THAT THERE WAS NO IMPACT TO WATERWAYS.

CCHSHMP DETERMINED SCENE WAS SAFE FROM HAZARDOUS MATERIALS AT APPROXIMATELY 18:00 HOURS.

AT APPROXIMATELY 18:00 HOURS CCCHS HMP DEPARTED SCENE.
