5/30/2021 07:23 - Contra Costa Hazmat Programs (CCHMP) was notified of a railcar that had a valve blown off which resulted in unknown amounts of unknown liquid to be leaking. CCHMP was requested to respond to the incident. ConFire made it on scene and surveyed the scene. A BNSF representative was also there and determined that it was a pressure relief valve (PRV) that was releasing argon under normal operating procedures. The release stopped and CCHMP was notified to cancel the response. CCHMP turned around and did not make it to the scene.
